An inside view of the new County Library

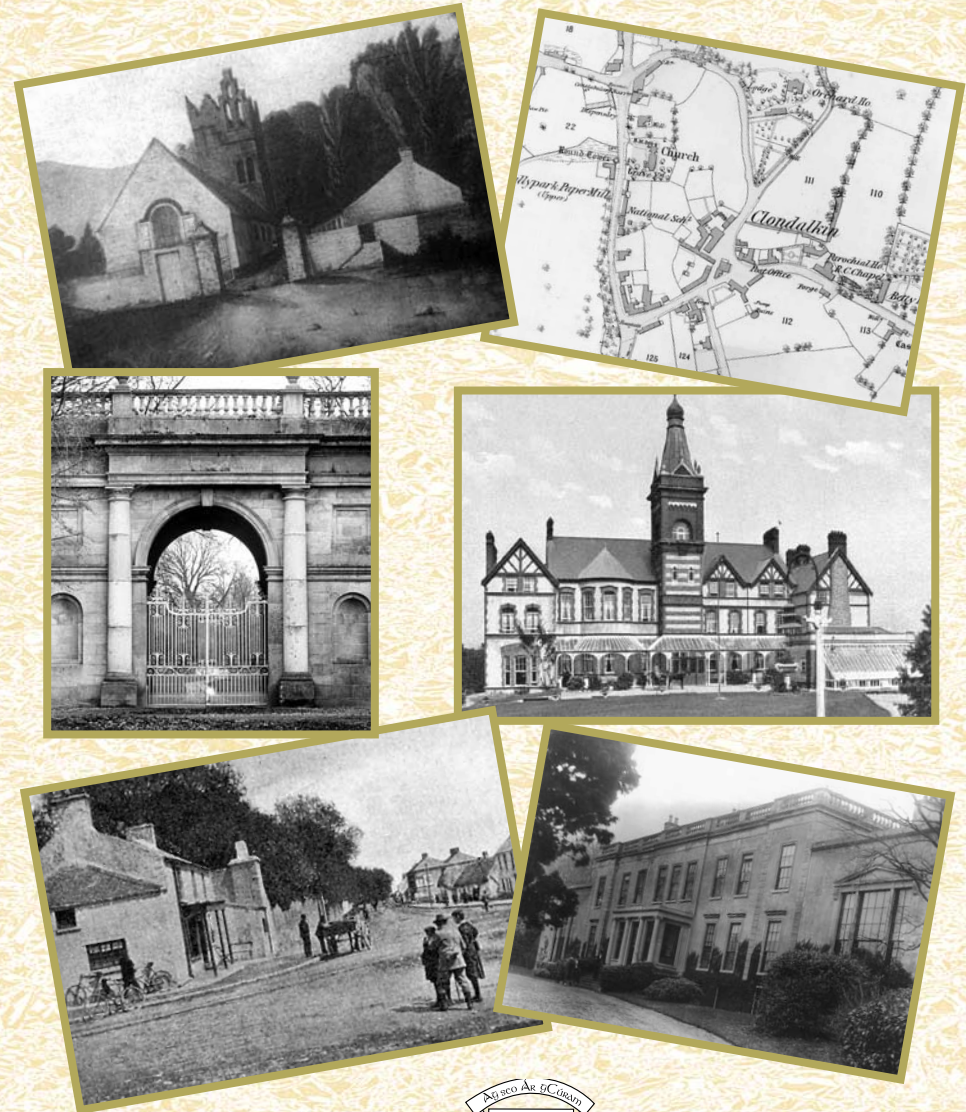
While the administrative County of South Dublin came into existence as recently as January 1994, the area it serves has a long and varied history and possesses a rich heritage.
