



Specimen heritage tree to be planted within front garden of the cottages

The front gardens of numbers 1, 2 and 3 Millview Terrace will be restored as cottage gardens, with low boxed hedges separating the lawns, small shrubs and small flower and bulb planting. The existing boundary lines of each garden will be maintained

New paved footpath from the entrance gate to the museum entrance and continuing along in front of the terrace of houses

Proposed new terrace to the rear of the extension which will give access to the new community garden

New paved footpath from the entrance gate to the terrace, which will be laid to a gentle slope without the need for steps or sudden changes of level

New timber and stainless steel public seating positioned on the former boundaries of the cottage gardens

The site and layout of the medieval village in the southwest corner of the garden will be indicated with paving and surface materials. The village was excavated and recorded by an archaeologist in 2008

New tree and shrub planting to screen the boundary wall to the south of the garden

New timber and stainless steel public seating positioned on the former boundaries of the cottage gardens

The existing houses are to be refurbished and adapted for use as a new visitors' centre

Proposed new extension to the rear of numbers 1, 2 & 3 Millview Terrace which will contain an exhibition space, toilets, service area and a stairs

New paved footpath from the entrance gate to the terrace

Existing specimen tree

A new gate will be made in the existing stone-filled opening in the stone wall which is lined with brickwork.

The area around the tower will be a new forecourt to the garden and will be finished with concrete and calp limestone setts

Existing monkey puzzle tree to be removed

A new main entrance gate will be made at the existing gate
