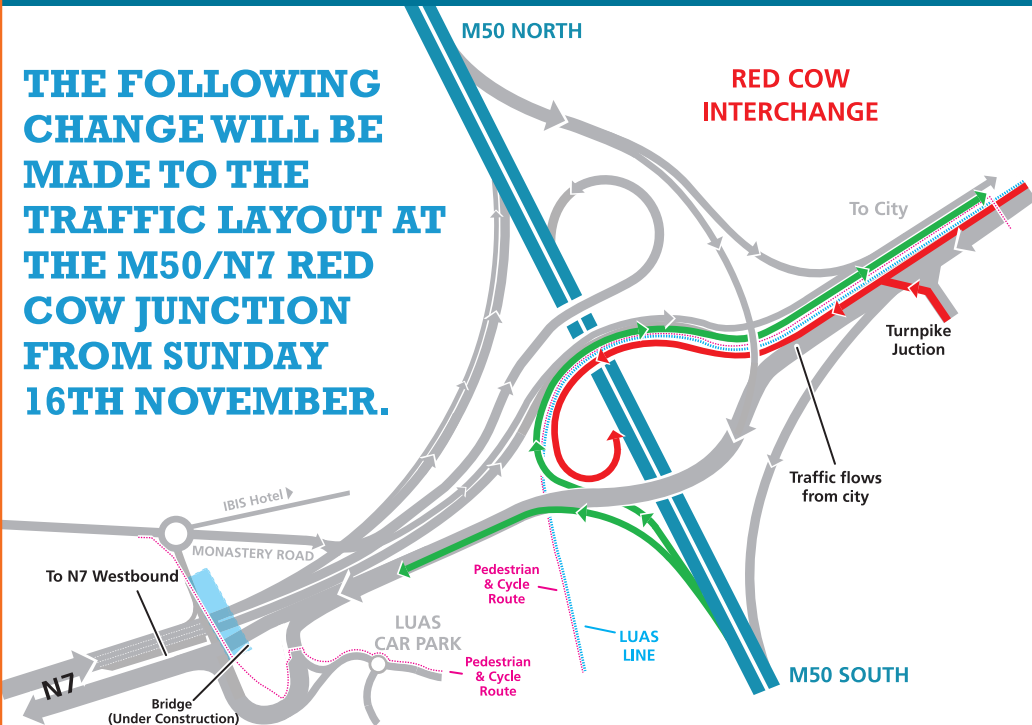


PROGRESS UPDATE M50

Change to Traffic Layout at M50/N7 (Red Cow) Junction 9 from Sunday 16th of November 2008

■ OUTBOUND NAAS RD (R110) TO M50 NORTHBOUND

- From the 16th November at 8am the new outbound Naas Rd (R110) to M50 northbound free-flow on-ramp will be opened to traffic.

■ BALLYMOUNT/TURNPIKE TO M50 NORTHBOUND

- From the 16th November at 8am Ballymount/Turnpike traffic can access the new Naas Rd (R110) to M50 northbound free-flow on-ramp through the traffic signals at the Naas Rd (R110)/Turnpike Junction.

■ M50 NORTHBOUND TO N7 OUTBOUND

- The new M50 northbound to N7 outbound and the M50 northbound to City off ramps have been opened. Temporary traffic signals will remain in place at the N7/Monastery Rd Junction until the new Overbridge (Bowstring Bridge) linking with Clondalkin is opened to traffic at the end of November 2008

OUTBOUND CLONDALKIN TRAFFIC

- Outbound Clondalkin traffic will continue to use the temporary "U-bend diversion" at the M50/N7 (Red Cow) Junction until the new Bowstring Bridge is opened to traffic at the end of November 2008.

The entire new traffic layout at the M50/N7 (Red Cow) Junction is expected to be in place by mid December '08. Finishing works with temporary traffic management to be continued into the new year.

Please exercise care when using the new layout
