RUA RED presents an installation of work by artist, Gary Somers.

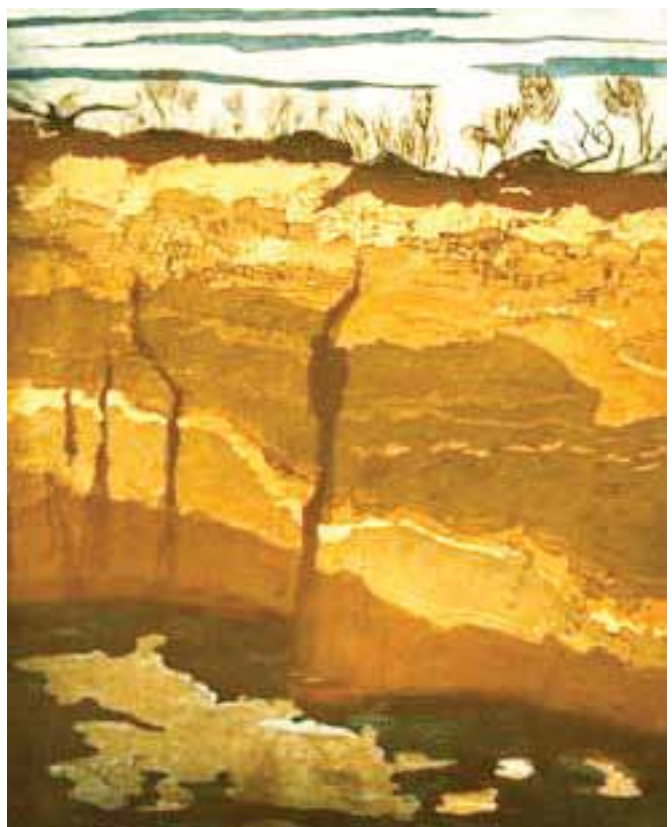
