



Upgrade of cycle tracks on both sides of Griffen Road

Proposed redesign of entrance at Griffen Road to include new kerb, car parking provision, new surfacing, relocation of bollards within the area, new planting, repair of fence at Castle Riada side and new access point to castle Riada Avenue and completion of low wall and hedge at Moy Glas side. All subject to detailed design

Proposed new path with relocated access point. Proposed piers at access point

Proposed clear stem trees
Proposed new path and access points at Moy Glas with proposed piers at access points

Proposed 4m wide shared walking and cycling route. Proposed public lighting. Location and detail to further design. Proposed CCTV, location and detail to further design

Discuss with landowner regarding removal/reducing height of existing evergreen trees

Proposed new raised table at junction

Proposed clear stem trees

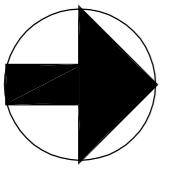
Proposed new path and access point from Moy Glas to R136, to include new wall and section of fence.

Access point to proposed new ramp. Proposed ramp with masonry finish to access new route. Proposed masonry wall to provide buffer between Moy Glas and ramp. Proposed fence to provide visual permeability between ramp and R136. (See Section B to B)

Proposed relocation of bus stop, upgrade of footpath and tles-ins as required

Upgrade of crossing to further detailed design and consideration, to include raised cycle tracks, local realignment of road, upgrade of existing entrance at eastern side of road

New access point from R136 to further detail. Proposed steps to access proposed walking and cycling route.
