Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 20 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended) that South Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County has prepared a **Draft Local Area Plan for Ballycullen - Oldcourt.**

An Environmental Report has been prepared as part of a Strategic Environmental Assessment of the proposed Local Area Plan. The proposed Local Area Plan has undergone Appropriate Assessment Screening under the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC).

The public consultation will take place from Friday 18th October 2013 to Thursday 28th November 2013 inclusive.
